We have recently done an emergency detention to the jail - a woman arrested from the ER, Travis County and District attorneys are committed to not criminalizing mental illness - so person had to be released from jail - with NO PLACE TO GO - the emergency detention order was to the jail. It is in our statute, but Houston, SanAntonio, and Dallas do not do this.
