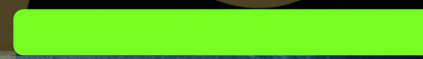

Data reports in progress

- National Association of State Mental Health Program Directors (NASMHPD) and the NASMHPD Research Institute (NRI) are working on 3 upcoming crisis services data reports:
 - A TAC paper on how 12 states with comprehensive crisis systems use data across their crisis continuum
 - A 2-part Webinar in May on the TAC paper findings with Georgia, Tennessee and Utah sharing examples of their data collection/dashboards/visualizations they use to manage their crisis systems
 - A 2022 State Profiles component focusing on Crisis Services – survey about to be disseminated



Focus of upcoming State Profile survey

- Measures of capacity, funding, and other characteristics of:
 - Crisis Call Centers
 - Mobile Crisis Teams
 - Less than 24-hour Crisis Stabilization Centers
 - Crisis Residential Programs
- Other Crisis Services Supported by SMHA
- Technology Used To Support Crisis Continuum
- Transportation for Clients Needing Crisis Services
- Building, Sustaining, and Training the Workforce for Crisis Services
