Kansas SB 19 was signed by the Governor. Includes \$10 million in annually recurring state general funds to support 988 through 2026.

New Jersey S. 311 was heard, amended, and passed out of Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee on Monday. Primary change was to remove the telecom fee authorization and replace it with a required study of funding sources, including a potential fee, due by April 1, 2023.

South Carolina's legislature is debating 988 funding in their budget bill, H 5150. Right now, \$1-1.3 million is being considered to support a second call center.
