

# CONGRESSIONAL OUTLOOK: WHAT WAS INCLUDED IN THE EOY PACKAGE

## FY 2023 APPROPRIATIONS

- SAMHSA funded at \$7.5 billion (\$970 million increase)
- \$1.01 billion for Mental Health Block Grant (\$150 million increase)
  - Continues 5% crisis care set-aside in MHBG
- \$502 million for 988 & Behavioral Health Crisis Services (\$390 million increase)
  - Includes \$7 million for the 988 Coordinating Office
- \$385 million for Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic program (\$70 million increase)
- \$20 million for Mental health crisis response grants (\$10 million increase)
- \$28.2 million for national strategy for suicide prevention
- \$43.8 million for Garrett Lee Smith state grants and \$8.5 million for campus grants
- \$30 million for CDC Comprehensive Suicide Prevention Program (\$10 million increase)

## PROGRAM AUTHORIZATIONS

- Mental Health Crisis Response Partnership Pilot Program
- Behavioral Health Crisis Coordinating Office
- Medicare coverage for mobile crisis response teams through physician fee schedule
- State guidance from CMS on crisis services coverage under Medicaid and CHIP
- Publication of best practices for the crisis response continuum of care


