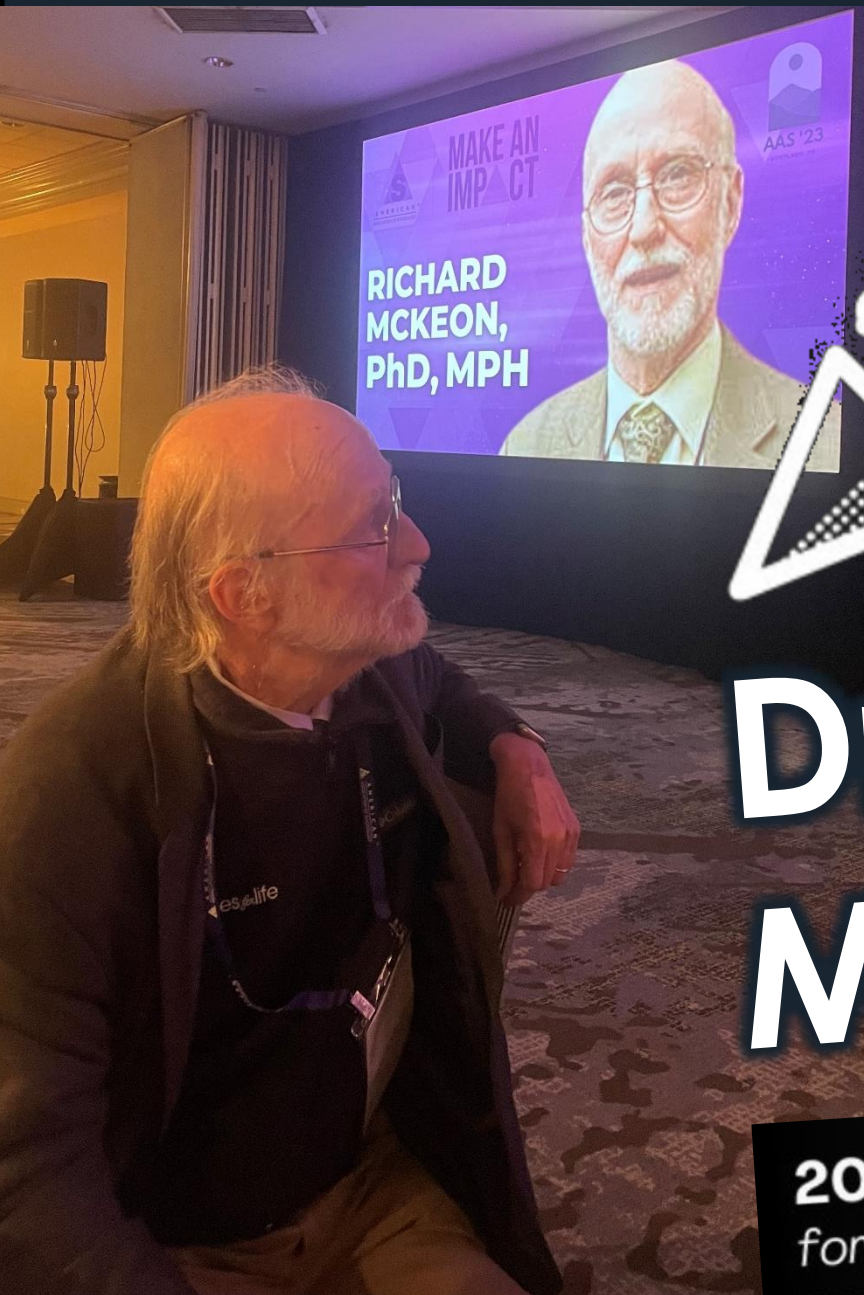

Zero Suicide proposes that all suicides are preventable, even up until the last moment. In 2018, Dr. Richard McKeon clarified this view, “This doesn’t mean a family has the power to stop it, nor that even a clinician, who has a duty to care, has the power to stop it under all circumstances. We mean that no suicide is fated. None are pre-destined. Until the person actually takes a final lethal act, there is still hope.”
