




### In 2022, SMHAs were supporting:

- Over 544 BH Crisis Call Centers
  - >200 Lifeline/988 Call Centers
  - >344 Other State and Local Crisis Call Centers
- Over 1,287 Mobile Crisis Teams
  - With plans to open at least 173 more MCTs in 2023
- Over 237 <24-Hour Crisis Receiving and Stabilization Facilities
  - With plans to open at least 139 more CRSFs in 2023




### Status of Mobile Crisis and <24-Hour Crisis Stabilization Programs Availability Statewide 24/7 in 2022
