

HOUSE LABOR, HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FY 2024 APPROPRIATIONS BILL

- Provides \$103.3 billion to the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), which is \$14 billion (12%) below the FY23 enacted level and \$25.9 billion below the President's Budget Request.
- Funds SAMHSA at \$7.1 billion, a cut of \$234 million below the FY23 Level, including:
 - \$385m in Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) grants.
 - Continues Mental Health Block Grant crisis set-aside at 5%.

Next Steps

- Further information on individual programmatic funding levels will be available when committee report is released in advance of the full committee markup.
- Overall HHS spending levels will be higher in the Senate.
- FY24 begins on October 1.
- If all 12 bills aren't signed into law before 2024, 1% sequestration goes into effect.
