Research Questions and Data

- Research objective: To identify the factors associated with a CCBHC...
 - Offering crisis services directly vs. through a designated collaborating organization (DCO)
 - Adding crisis services after becoming a CCBHC vs. before
- Methods: Analysis of national survey data on CCBHC crisis services paired with data on clinic features and the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of the counties within a CCBHC service area

Conclusion & Policy Implication

- Finding: Clinics that received a CCBHC Medicaid bundled payment → more likely to have added mobile crisis response and crisis stabilization after CCBHC designation than clinics that did not receive this payment
- Why: Structure of CCBHC Medicaid bundled payments may be a sustainable financial foundation for service line expansions necessary to fulfill CCBHC criteria
- Policy Implication: CCBHC Medicaid bundled payments may be a policy solution effective at increasing the availability of some crisis services nationally.
