

# Scaling Coordinated Specialty Care for First-Episode Psychosis: Insights From a National Impact Model

- Kennedy Forum's “90-90-90” vision for mental health by 2033
- Coordinated Specialty Care (CSC) dramatically improves outcomes & the number of programs has grown significantly in the past 2 decades BUT...
- Only 10-15% of individuals in early psychosis have access to CSC in the US
- Estimated impacts of scaling up to serve 90% of individuals with early psychosis over the next decade
- We'd **save \$115-\$137 billion** compared to the current system
- **Improve the lives of 600,000-800,000 individuals**, their families & communities
- Adding years to life & life to years
