Mobile Crisis
Survey Is Coming
Fall 2025!

We are launching a national survey of “Mobile Crisis Programs” in Fall 2025 to build on the evidence base about mobile crisis programs across the United States. This project expands upon an initial national survey conducted by our team in 2023 (see first survey report linked [here](#).)

Our goals:

1. Produce accessible information about the state of mobile crisis programs across the country.
2. Advance shared definitions about model types and essential metrics for the “someone to respond” element of the crisis continuum.

What do we want to know?

We are interested in knowing how programs are organized and operate, what types of professionals make up teams, who they serve, what technology they leverage, how they are financed, and what kinds of data they collect.

Who should take the survey?

We are surveying mobile crisis program “directors” or people who oversee or are highly familiar with the operations of the team providing mobile responses.

Mobile crisis programs include the following models:

- Behavioral health provider mobile crisis programs
- Mobile Response and Stabilization Services (MRSS) programs
- Alternative/Community Response Programs
- Co-Responder Programs

Anticipated Products:

- State-level profiles on the mobile crisis program landscape in 5 states
- Report on the national mobile crisis programs
- Standardized framework for mobile crisis program data collection



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
